• TIPS FOR HOMEOWNERS

- o Keep all doors, including the garage, locked at all times.
- \circ $\;$ Do not post or tell anyone when you plan to be out of your house, such as when you are going on vacation.
- $\circ\quad$ If you will be away from home, have a trusted neighbor or friend collect your mail.
- Avoid any scams by researching the sender and verifying their credibility.

TIPS FOR DRIVERS

- \circ Avoid leaving valuables inside your car. If it is necessary, lock them in the trunk, out of sight.
- Always be aware of your surroundings, especially in neighborhoods where children like to play.
- $\circ~$ Drive safely and slowly around public areas, as there is much more foot traffic, especially $\it little\, feet.$

TIPS FOR PARENTS

- o Teach your child how to call 911 in case of an emergency.
- $\circ\quad$ Create a list of contacts for your neighbors so they can assist your child if necessary.
- $\circ\quad$ Make sure to know the route your child takes to and from certain locations.
- Create a set of rules for your child's internet usage. Teach them that it is never okay to give out any personal information without your permission.
- \circ $\;$ Teach your child that traveling in groups is safer, and to always check in before they plan to do anything.
- Have your child wear protective gear, such as helmets, when biking/skating.
