Briefing by Abby Sterling, PhD
Director of the Georgia Bight Shorebird Conservation Initiative

Dr. Sterling presented what the Georgia Bight Shorebird Conservation Initiative does for the does and how the Town of Seabrook Island can be designated as a site of hemispheric importance within this conservation effort.
