PUBLIC SAFETY TIPS

Vehicle Break-ins, Stolen Vehicle Parts, and Stolen Vehicles on are the rise! Please keep the following tips in mind to prevent you from falling victim to these crimes:

- **MOST IMPORTANT: Lock your vehicles!** Most assailants who steal vehicles begin with pulling handles of the vehicle. If locked, most of the time, they will move on to the next vehicle
- Do not leave valuable items inside your vehicle
- Do not have any valuables or important items that can be easily seen through the car windows or in plain view
- If you must leave any important item in your vehicle, lock it in the trunk of your vehicle
- Don't leave your keys/key fob inside your vehicle, especially in plain view

It is still Tax season. During this time, there are many who try to steal your tax returns by calling the IRS and filing under your name. Our wonderful Analysts from the CCSO Crime Analysis Unit wanted to share this added safety tip for you, since this is around the time people begin to receive their tax returns.

Sign up for the FREE Post Office informed delivery service. You sign up and put in your email. This amazing service lets you see mail that will be soon delivered to you, as well as updated images. This is a great tool to make sure that your IRS Tax returns and supporting documents for your tax filing, if mailed to you, is not stolen.



ALWAYS REMEMBER

If you *See Something, Say Something*. Tell a first responder. Call 911 or call the non-emergency number at **843-743-7200**. **IMPORTANT:** Teach your child how to call 911 in case of an emergency.
