PUBLIC SAFETY TIPS

Did you know April is also Distracting Driving Awareness Month?

Charleston County Sheriff's Office wants to make sure everyone is safe when behind the wheel, thus CCSO has some tips to keep you and your passengers safe on the road. Distracted Driving is any activity that could divert a person's attention away from the primary task of driving.

Three Main Types of Distraction

The three main types of distraction are Visual, manual, and cognitive. Visual distraction is when you take your eyes off the road. Manual distraction is taking your hands off the wheel. Cognitive or mental distraction is taking your mind off what you are doing. Examples of these distractions are cellphones, eating and drinking, GPS, and talking to passengers. Texting involves all three types of distractions!

How To Avoid Distracted Driving

Visual Distraction. Avoiding visual distractions include keeping your eyes on the road, pulling over to read directions, and putting your phone in "Do Not Disturb" mode.

Manual Distraction. You can avoid manual distractions by keeping your phone out of reach, making all adjustments before driving, and not reaching for items while driving.

Cognitive Distraction. To avoid cognitive or mental distractions, avoid phone calls, even hands-free, stay focused on the road, and keeping your emotions in check.

ALWAYS REMEMBER

If you *See Something, Say Something*. Tell a first responder. Call 911 or call the non-emergency number at [843-743-7200](tel:843-743-7200). **IMPORTANT:** Teach your child how to call 911 in case of an emergency.
